## **PERMANENT CALL**

### **Joint Projects (JP):**

*Submission:* **submission possible at any time**

*Project Duration:* up to 3 years

*Decision:* continuously

Joint Projects are bilateral research projects which are based on a **close integration** of the project parts in Austria and Russia. Scientists from Russia and from Austria apply **simultaneously** for their respective project parts **at their country's organisation**, using the forms prescribed by their national funding agency. The **titles** of both applications **must be the same**. The applications are evaluated separately by FWF and RFBR. Only if **both organisations approve** the respective proposals, the Joint Project will be funded.

### **Application guidelines for FWF Applicants:**

### **Eligible Scientific Fields:**

- 01 mathematics, mechanics, informatics;
- 02 physics and astronomy;
- 03 chemistry;
- 04 biology and medical science;
- 05 earth sciences;
- 06 humanities and social sciences (*Applicants should contact RFBR regarding the possibility of funding their topic.*)
- 07 information, computer and telecommunication resources;
- 08 fundamentals of engineering sciences

### **Joint Seminars (JS)**

*Aim:* Preparation of common project applications

*Submission deadline:* **submission possible at any time, but at least six months prior to envisaged date of the Joint Seminar**

*Location:* Russia or Austria

Scientists from Russia and Austria apply at their country's respective funding organisation. The titles of both applications must be the same.

The "**sending organisation**" will meet the expenses up to the nearest airport/railway station of the visited location for a maximum number of 8 scientists (international travel expenses).

The "**receiving side**" will pick up the visiting scientists from/to airport/ railway stations and cover their local costs.

FWF currently funds JS up to a maximum sum of **10.000,- EUR** per seminar.
