the *Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS)* and  
the *Austrian Science Fund (FWF)***

**Joint Projects (JP)**

<b>Deadline for Applications:</b>	<b>September 12, 2011</b> (FWF: postmark)
<b>Max. Duration:</b>	<b>2 years</b>
<b>Max. no. of Joint Projects to be financed:</b>	<b>3</b>

Applicants from Japan and from Austria have to submit **parallel applications** for their national project parts at JSPS and FWF respectively. The applications must follow the guidelines of the respective funding agency. Applications for Joint Projects must show a clear **scientific added value** due to the international cooperation. Applicants at FWF can apply for a third year, given that a scientific justification as well as a justification of costs for the third year are included in the application.

**Information for applicants at FWF:**

For applications at FWF the “**Application Guidelines for Stand Alone Projects**” (“Antragsrichtlinien für Einzelprojekte”) apply (downloadable at <http://www.fwf.ac.at/de/applications/p-einzelprojekte.html>). Applicants should also pay attention to the “**Infoblatt Joint Projects**”. In addition to the application documents mentioned in the application guidelines, applicants must send the **application form**, the sheet “**programme specific data**” form as well as the **cost-sheet** to FWF. All documents must be submitted to FWF as **hard-copy** as well as on a **CD-Rom**.

<b>No. of Joint Seminars to be financed:</b>	<b>1</b>

### Eligible costs:

Scientists from Japan and Austria apply at their country's respective funding organisation. The **titles** of both applications **must be the same**. The "sending organisation" pays the international travel costs for its country's group members, while the "hosting organisation" covers local costs, including the guests' hotel costs. Applicants at FWF should consult the "**Antragsrichtlinien für Joint Seminars**" (Application Guidelines for Joint Seminars) for details.
