Clinical Research (KLIF) call

Differences from the General Principles of Decision-making Procedures

KLIF international Jury

The FWF has established an international Jury for the Clinical Research (KLIF) call, and this international Jury will submit approval recommendations to the FWF Board on the basis of the reviews received. The international Jury will consist of international experts in clinical research (8 to 12 persons) who cover as broad a range of disciplines as possible within the field. The FWF Board will decide whether to approve project applications on the basis of the international Jury's recommendations.

Selection process

In this initiative, the FWF will use a single-stage selection process based on a call for proposals. Projects will be selected on a competitive basis within the constraints of the available budget, which will determine the number of projects which can be supported.

Process:

- Submission of the application to FWF by the principal investigator
- Formal review of application by the FWF Secretariat
- Review of applications by the international Jury in cooperation with additional international experts (peer reviewers)
- Approval recommendation by the KLIF international Jury on the basis of the peer reviews
- Decision on project approval by the FWF Board

Decision and granting of funds

The FWF Board will decide whether to grant funding on the basis of the international Jury's recommendations. Applicants will be informed of the grant decision in writing.

For the decision of a project, approval from the responsible ethics committee is required at latest by September 1st.
